ESCALANTE CITY ORDINANCE 2024-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ESCALANTE CITY CODE NO. 1.32.020 SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTIVE AND STATUTORY OFFICERS AND PROVIDING REPEALER WITHIN THE CITY OF ESCALANTE, STATE OF UTAH.

WHEREAS, Utah law 10-3-818 provides that elective and statutory officers in municipalities may only receive compensation for services pursuant to ordinance enacted by the legislative body following a public hearing;

WHEREAS, the elected and statutory officials of Escalante City include the Mayor, Councilmembers, City Attorney, City Manager and Planning Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Escalante City, in the State of Utah, as follows:

SECTION 1: <u>AMENDMENT</u> "1.32.020 Compensation" of the Escalante Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

1.32.020 Compensation

- A. Specified: The monthly compensation of the elected <u>and statutory officers officials</u> shall be as follows:
 - 1. Mayor \$300.00150.00
 - 2. Council member 100.00\$200.00
 - 3. City Attorney- \$1,500.00
 - 4. Justice court judge 200.00
- <u>B.</u> Payment By Mail: The <u>recorder treasurer</u> or deputy <u>recorder treasurer</u> shall pay each elected and statutory officer by mailing the check to the elected officer at his home, postage prepaid.
- C. Per Diem: Each member of the governing body shall receive mileage and per diem for all trips approved by the city council.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2024.
